### BIODIVERSITY IN THE ART OF CAREL PIETER BREST VAN KEMPEN TRAVELING EXHIBITION

Biodiversity in the Art of Carel Pieter Brest van Kempfen premiered at The Wildlife Experience Museum in Denver, and was subsequently displayed at the Wildling Art Museum near Santa Barbara, CA, the Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum in Tucson, The Hiram Blauvelt Art Museum in Oradell, NJ, just outside New York City, and the Kenosha Public Museum, located midway between Chicago and Milwaukee. The exhibition is comprised of over three dozen original paintings, plus a selection of corresponding preparatory drawings, all of which reflect the range and versatility of the artist. The exhibition is accompanied by didactic label content prepared by the artist himself, and a recently published, fully-illustrated book authored by Carel Pieter Brest van Kempfen, which includes an introduction by Curator, Dr. David J. Wagner.
